

# Allianz NACM Income & Growth Fund



## A diversified way to target the total return potential of equity securities

The Fund is a core holding that invests in equities, high yield and convertible bonds and typically writes call options on approximately 70% of the value of each stock position. As a result, the Fund aims to capture multiple sources of income while participating in the upside potential of equities, with potentially less volatility than a pure stock investment.

## Why invest in this fund?

### Multiple opportunities for income plus the growth potential of equities

High-quality, large-cap stocks provide capital appreciation and income. Covered calls can provide additional income from option premiums. High yield bonds may provide high income with potentially less volatility than stocks, though at greater credit risk than high-grade bonds. Convertible bonds provide income and capital appreciation, but with bond-like volatility.

### The potential to be less volatile than a pure stock investment

The Fund provides most of the upside potential in equity markets while offering income which can cushion against declines. Covered calls can reduce exposure to equity market volatility. Convertible bonds can help investors participate in equity price appreciation, but with risk characteristics reflecting the bond component. High yield bonds have low correlation with other asset classes, and can improve the riskreward profile of a portfolio.

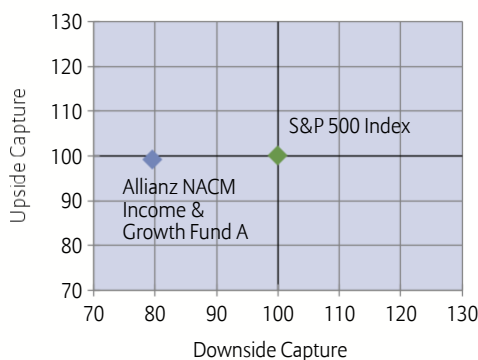
### Access to Nicholas-Applegate's disciplined investment process

The managers employ bottom-up companyspecific analysis with extensive credit research to identify companies exhibiting signs of sustainable positive change. Equity and bond issues of "buy" candidates are evaluated for an optimal balance of income generation and capital appreciation potential. The best total return candidates are ultimately included in the portfolio.

## Keeps Pace with Equity Upside and Moderates Volatility

Because of the Allianz NACM Income & Growth Fund's convertibles strategy, the Fund has been able to offer exposure to 99% of the upside participation in the underlying equity with 79% of the downside risk, producing a very attractive risk/reward profile. This is based on an analysis of since inception returns as of September 30, 2009. While the fund may have captured less of the market's downside, it may still have negative returns under current market conditions.

### Positive Upside/Downside Capture



This chart displays the percentage of benchmark movement captured by a manager in both up and down markets. The "capture ratio" is the manager's return divided by the benchmark's return, or the percentage of the benchmark's return that was "captured" by the manager. The upside capture ratio is computed for periods when the market has a positive return. The downside capture ratio is computed for periods when the market has a negative return. The crosshairs, which provide a basis for comparison, are centered at 100%, which is where the benchmark itself will always fall. Bear in mind that the options component and convertibles may inhibit the fund from participating fully in positive equity markets. Options strategies also involve special risks.

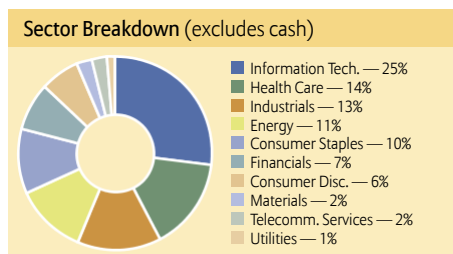

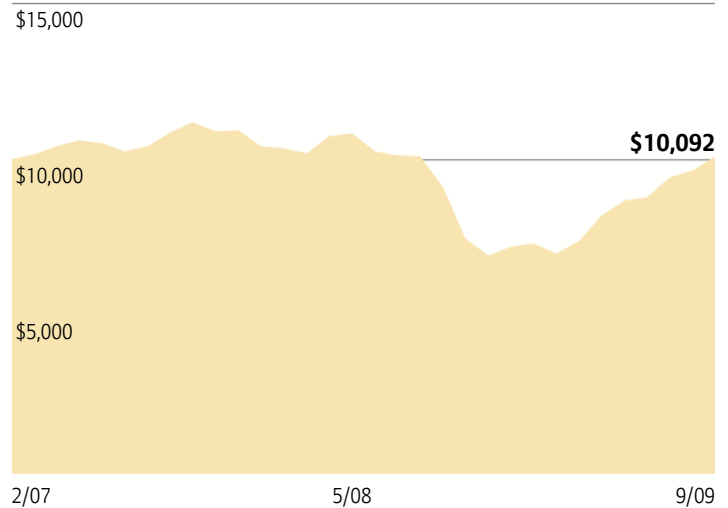

The Fund may invest a significant portion of its assets in securities that have not been registered for public sale, but that are eligible for purchase and sale by qualified institutional buyers. The Fund may utilize foreign currency exchange contracts, options, stock index futures contracts and other derivative instruments. Use of derivative instruments may involve certain costs and risks such as liquidity risk, interest rate risk, market risk, credit risk, management risk and the risk that a fund could not close out a position when it would be most advantageous to do so.
