Dear Shareholder:

Please find enclosed your 2007 Form 1099-DIV and Form 1099-B relating to the PIMCO Funds and Allianz Funds.

Income / Capital Gains Paid as Dividend Distributions (Form 1099-DIV)

Mutual funds may realize capital gains as a result of the buying and selling of securities within a mutual fund portfolio. These gains are passed onto shareholders in the form of capital gain dividend distributions and are reported to shareholders as a taxable capital gain on Form 1099-DIV. Short-term capital gain distributions are included in box (1) of Form 1099-DIV along with income dividends and are taxable as ordinary income. Long-term capital gain distributions are reported in box (2a) of Form 1099-DIV. Non-taxable dividend distributions are reported in box (3) and represent a reclassification of income and/or dividend received during the year.

Capital Gains When Selling Your Shares (Form 1099-B)

Each time mutual fund shares are sold (redeemed), a capital gain or loss is realized if the selling price is different than the cost basis of the shares sold. Included in this packet is a Form 1099-B reporting all redemptions you made during 2007. For those accounts that are eligible, the Average Cost Basis is provided along with the amount and character of Gain (Loss) for each redemption. Please be aware that any realized loss on a December 2007 redemption may be disallowed due to a subsequent purchase in January 2008 that falls within the 30-day wash sale window. In order to fully report the impact of wash sales, a second Average Cost Statement will be mailed to applicable accounts no later than February 20, 2008. Shareholders must report gains or losses on sales of mutual fund shares on their tax return on Schedule D (Form 1040). Short-Term Capital Gains (Losses) are disclosed on Part I of Schedule D and Long-Term Capital Gains (Losses) are disclosed on Part II of Schedule D.
